

HAZARD WARNING

Auspit firedishes are used to contain fire safely. Large amounts of radiant heat are emitted to the sides and downward from the dish. The dish should not be used where material below or around the dish can burn (eg timber porch or patio) and must be operated on earth or gravel locations.

The firedish should be operated in outdoor surroundings and be free and clear of any flammable substance or building directly above and 2 metres (80ins) surrounding the firedish.

The Auspit™ cooking system contains pointed components and uses heat sources that can cause injury. Care must be taken and recommend the use of heat resistant gloves. Please keep out of the reach of children at all times and supervise when in use.

This guide should be read fully before commencing with operation

- The Auspit firedish has been designed to let you enjoy heating, cooking and safe use of fire in the outdoors or at home.
- Made In stainless steel, all with removable legs
- The Stainless steel 304 model requires no maintenance, can be washed out and stored without treatment, occasionally oil or grease threads and nuts on leg mounts.
- A method of extinguishment should always be available when using the fire dishes.
- Be aware of fire restrictions and weather conditions during gazetted fire danger periods.
- The Auspit firedish should be under supervision at all times during use.
